VILLAGE OF CHANGPAS -KORZOK

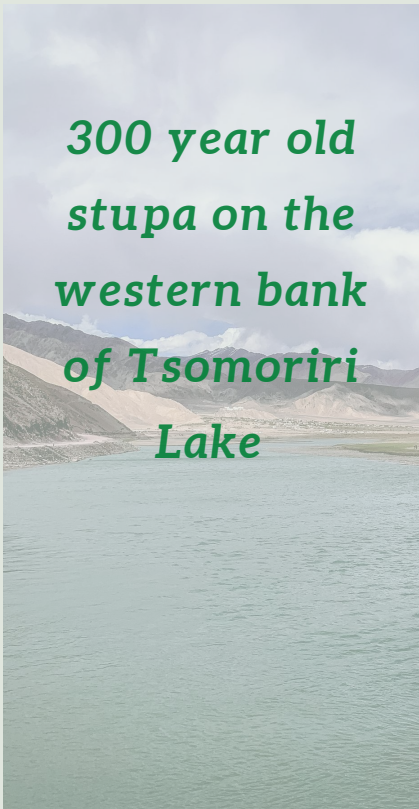
Perched at an altitude of 4,510m, the village of Korzok lies on the banks of Tso Moriri, one of the highest lakes in India.
